The present document is a Perspective Plan of action of the institute. The institute has focused on the roadmap for the academic departments, infrastructural facilities, administrative office, library, research, information technology, student support, gymkhana, extra - curricular activities, campus beautification and environmental awareness. The following is the year wise plan of action for the further development:

• ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS

The institute runs 08 academic departments under Arts and Commerce faculties. Every department will try to strengthen the teaching- learning process by practicing the following activities-

2019-20 to 2024-25

1. Syllabus Announcement

Tentative Action Plan for the curriculum delivery will be prepared by each teacher at the beginning of the academic year. Every teacher will note the changes made by the University authorities in the syllabus.

2. The Diagnostic Test for identifying the learning levels of students:

This examination will help to check the level of prior subject knowledge of the students enrolled. This will also help the teachers to plan the teaching schedule as per the level and needs of the slow and advanced learners. The remedial coaching will be provided to slow learners and their progress will be monitored. At the same time the advanced learners will be encouraged to take on advanced studies.

3. Departmental Academic Planning:

Department wise academic planning for each activity will be prepared at the beginning of the academic year.

The planning will incorporate the following components:

- A. Teaching plan. (Term/Semester wise)
- B. Daily Lesson Notes.
- C. Comparison of planned syllabus with the actual syllabus taught.
- D. Syllabus Completion Report. (Per Term/Semester)
- E. Solutions, if the syllabus isincomplete.
- F. Co- curricular activities.

4. Continuous Internal Evaluation:

We have internalized and institutionalised the continuous internal evaluation system to judge the academic progress of the students. Accordingly, we conduct two unit tests in each term and Mid Term Examination including homework, presentations, tutorials, projects, assignments, tutorials, solving of university question papers of previous examinations etc. This is planned by all departments.

5. Attendance:

In order to confirm the presence of the students in the class and ensure their participation in co- curricular and extra-curricular activities, the attendance will be taken regularly.

6. Participation and organization of Seminars, Conferences and Workshops:

The syllabus of each subject changes after every two or three years as well as there are updates in some topics. Therefore, a teacher must be acquainted with these changes and updates. By considering all these, maximum teachers will be encouraged to participate actively in syllabus restructuring workshops and seminars which are related to recent trends in respective subjects. Seminars/conferences/workshops on recent trends will be organized in association with affiliating university and other funding agencies.

7. Lead College Scheme (An Innovative Step by Shivaji University, Kolhapur)

To enhance the quality of affiliated colleges, Shivaji University, Kolhapur has initiated quality enhancement programme for enriching performance of the students in the field of academics and research. The funds are made available to organize seminars, workshops and lectures of experts to orient the students.

8. Publications:

Each teacher is an expert in his/her subject. It will be planned to motivate them by giving incentives to publish the articles in the newspaper, subject related magazines and peer reviewed journals especially the journals recognized by U.G.C. with highest impact factor will be preferred for publications. Seed money will be provided to the teachers and students for the research.

9. Short Term Courses:

Employability has been a great concern nowadays. We envision running various skill based short term courses to make students self-employable. In forthcoming academic years, the college plans to start short term courses like Mycron, Fashion Designing, Soft Toys, Imitation Jewelry, Beauty Parlor, Basic Computer, Graphics, Tally, English Speaking Course etc. Every department will conduct a short term course in a year with a specific theme.

10. New Courses:

A new UG programme i.e. B.Sc. will be introduced for which online application mode will be followed.

11. Academic and Administrative Audit (A.A.A.)

The parent institute and external agency will assess and audit the performance of the college every year. The committee will give suggestions and inputs for the quality enhancement of the institute.

12. Rayat Avishkar:

To respond positively to Rayat Avishkar, the initiative of our parent institute the project work will be assigned to advanced learners every year to inculcate research culture among the students. Special efforts will be taken by faculty for this practice. The innovative projects will be presented in Research Project/ Poster Presentation Competition *'Rayat Avishkar'*.

13. Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule Students Forum:

The main objectives of this symbiosis will be-
