The learning levels of students are assessed through the merit in previous examination and 'Diagnostic Tests'.

The following strategies are adopted for advanced learners:

- Provide a set of Text books under Siddhivinayak Book Bank Scheme.
- Additional reference books are provided on borrow cards.
- Open access to e-resources /INFLIBNET.
- Reference books, journals etc. are issued to advanced learners through departmental libraries as per their demand.
- Encourage them to undertake research projects and also for participation in *Avishkar* Research Project Competitions.
- Motivate them to undertake projects in private enterprises.
- Special guidance provided to such students to participate in various competitive exams like General knowledge exam, Civil Services exams etc.
- Permit them to spend more time in the departments and laboratories.
- Encourage them to participate in various Intercollegiate competitions such as Paper presentation, Poster Presentation, Model Preparation, Programming (C Programming, Web Designing, Android App Development Workshop) etc.
- Involvement of such students in organization of various student centric activities and college functions.
- Guest lectures and interactions with eminent personalities to broaden their perspective.

Following measures are taken for the development of the slow learners-

- The slow learners are provided with Remedial Coaching and counselling.
- Academic progress of slow learners is monitored through the Continuous Internal Evaluation.
- To enable the slow learners to cope up with the programmes of their choice, faculty-wise remedial coaching classes in the subjects like English, Economics, Accountancy etc. are conducted.
- Various add-on courses like Spoken English, TALLY, Personality Development etc. are run by the college which are helpful to the students to bridge their knowledge gap.

- Medium of instruction may be the local language along with the English / Hindi as the case arises.
- Personal, Academic and Social counselling is also conducted.
- Mentor- Mentee Scheme is also helpful in monitoring the academic progress of slow learners.
- Bridge course is availed to the B.Com. and B.C.A. students
